MODERNISATION UNDER MADURAI DIVISION

1185. SHRI KODIKUNNIL SURESH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed any modernization work in Kottarakkara and Avaneswaram Railway stations under Madurai division in Kerala;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and**
- (c) the details of facilities provided/proposed to be provided at these stations?**

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Kottarakkara and Avaneeswaram, both Railway stations, have been developed under Adarsh station scheme. All Minimum Essential Amenities have been provided at both the stations as per norms.

In addition, following works have been proposed at both the stations:-

- Provision of additional Fans.**
- Provision of Platform Shelters 2 bays each including replacement of damaged AC sheets with Galvalume sheets for Platform shelter and Foot over Bridge Roof.**
- Pay and Use Toilets in circulating area & Concourse.**
- Ramps at entry of station for physically challenged persons**
- Landscaping of circulating area at Avaneswaram.**
- Provision of LED clock with real time connectivity at Avaneeswaram.**
