**Decline of Coal Production in Private Sector**

**1265. PROF. CHINTAMANI MALVIYA :**

- (a) whether the production of coal has declined in the private sector in the country;
- (b) if so, the production of coal in each of the coal mine in private sector in the country during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the percentage of coal produced by private sector in the country?

**(a) to (c):** No, Madam. Coal production by private sector has increased from 32.55 MT in 2015-16 to 34.75 MT in 2017-18. The details of coal produced by private sector (company-wise/mine-wise) during the last three years and current year is given below:
