- (a) the Rail Over Bridges (ROBs) in Maharashtra the construction work of which is pending at present;
- (b) the reasons therefor project-wise;
- (c) the present status of construction work of the said pending ROBs, project-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has set any target for the completion of the said pending ROBs and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): As per Pink Book 2018-19, work for construction of 107 Road Over Bridges (ROBs) have been sanctioned in the State of Maharashtra on cost sharing basis. Out of these, 06 Road Over Bridges have been completed and the work on 20 ROBs work is in progress. A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed on 19.12.2017 between Ministry of Railways, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, and State Government of Maharashtra for construction of remaining Road Over Bridges on Single Entity basis by Government of Maharashtra including Railway portion. Therefore, further action will be taken by State Government of Maharashtra.
