(c) & (d): In order to achieve the objective of developing a professional, impartial and efficient civil service, responsive to the needs of the citizens, the Government has already adopted quality training system for its officers & employees. The training is being imparted to Government employees not only at induction stage but at different intervals in the course of their careers to equip them with the competencies for their current or future jobs. Government has also been funding the induction training programmes of State Governments for its employees and providing support for augmenting infrastructure of State Administrative Training Institutes.
