## SHRIMATI KAVITHA KALVAKUNTLA:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has constituted an Inter-Ministerial Task Force (IMTF) to undertake a comprehensive review of existing coal sources of Independent Power Producers (IPPs) having linkages and consider the feasibility for rationalisation of these sources with a view to optimize transportation cost;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the methodology for linkage rationalisation of power producers has been accepted by the Government recently; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

## **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COAL & FINANCE AND CORPORATE AFFAIRS (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. An Inter-Ministerial Task Force (IMTF) was constituted in July, 2017 to undertake a comprehensive review of existing coal sources of IPPs having linkages and consider the feasibility for rationalization of these sources with a view to optimize transportation cost given the various technical constraints. The underlying objective behind the exercise was to reduce the landed cost of coal due to reduction in transportation cost.
- (c) & (d): The methodology for linkage rationalization for IPPs has been accepted by the Government and the same has been circulated on 15.05.2018 to the CIL/SCCL to implement the methodology.
