- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Estimated loss of property in the collapse of Road Over Bridge in Andheri, Mumbai is approximately is ₹.88.54 lakh.
- (c) & (d): Commissioner of Railway Safety/Western Circle has been nominated for conducting enquiry. Enquiry is in progress.
- (e): One such incidence has taken place previously in Gujarat State (Ahmedabad) on 03.10.2015 where loss of property was \overline{v} .8.50 lakh and no life was lost.
