SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN TOLL PLAZAS

1481. DR. KIRIT SOMAIYA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether the Government has planned to install video surveillance system in all the toll plazas to monitor traffic;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has identified the toll plazas where this system will be installed in first phase;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the total cost to cover all toll plazas in the country by this system?

(a) Yes Madam.

(b) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) had invited e-bids from the eligible bidders for setting up Central Command & Control Centre at NHAI-HQ connected with Regional Offices and CCTV Surveillance & Monitoring of Vehicular Congestion on 210 Fee Plazas of National Highways. The project execution is on Service model and the period of engagement is five years.

(c) & (d) Yes Madam. A total of 210 number of fee plazas is selected for implementation of this project.

(e) Work was awarded to L1 bidder at a total cost of Rs. 36,03,56,380 for complete turnkey solution for setting up Central Command & Control Centre at NHAI-HQ connected with Regional Offices and Fee Plazas for a duration of five years.
