(a) to (c) The Government has approved Special package for completion of balance works of irrigation projects [83 Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI) Schemes & 8 Major/Medium Irrigation (MMI) projects including Jigaon project] benefitting Vidarbha and Marathwada and other chronically drought prone areas of rest of Maharashtra. The balance cost of these projects as on 01.04.2018 is Rs.13651.61 Cr. Central Assistance (CA) component amounts to Rs.3831.41 Cr.

The status of Jigaon project, as per information provided by the State Government is as follows:
