- (d) whether the officers of the Railways have been sent on deputation to any other department and if so, the details of such officers?**

(a): The total number of class one officers (called Group 'A' officers) working in the Indian Railways including the headquarters, as on 31.03.2017, is 9,741.

(b): Yes, Madam.

(c): At present, there are four officers who are on deputation in the Railways as per the details given below:-

Designation	Since when
i) Director General, Railway Protection Force(RPF)	21.08.2017
ii) Director, Vigilance Police	23.06.2016
iii) Appellate Authority, Metro Railway, Kolkata	08.04.2016
iv) Competent & Appellate Authority, Metro Railway, Kolkata	25.10.2016

(d): At present, there are 89 officers belonging to different Group 'A' Railway services who are on deputation to Central Government Departments/Ministries under the Central Staffing Scheme.
