CONDITION OF NHS

1562. SHRI JAGDAMBIKA PAL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

(a) whether the National Highways (NHs) passing through State of Uttar Pradesh including Siddhartha Nagar are in a dilapidated condition;

(b) if so, whether the Government has taken any action for repairing these NHs during the last three years and the current year;

(c) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which repair of these NHs is likely to be completed; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d) The development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) is a continuous process and the same is undertaken on the basis of availability of fund and inter-se-priority of works. In the last three years and current year Rs. 438.96 crore has been incurred towards maintenance of NHs in the State of Uttar Pradesh.

There are two stretches of NHs passing through Siddhartha Nagar namely NH-730 (km 385 to km 454) and NH-233 (km 0 to km 65.87). The work of 2 lane with paved shoulder (balance work) in km 0 to km 65.87 of NH-233 has recently been finalized. In the meanwhile, short term maintenance work to keep this stretch in traffic worthy condition has also been taken up by the Ministry. Strengthening work in km 420 to km 454 of NH-730 has been completed and the stretch is in traffic worthy condition. The work of 2 lane with paved shoulder in the stretch from km 385 to km 420 of NH-730 has been awarded and maintenance work has been taken up under ordinary repair to keep this stretch in traffic worthy condition.
