(a) No Madam.

(b) &(c) At present, user fee is levied & collected as per the provisions of the NH Fee Rules 2008/1997. The original NH Fee Rules 2008 have been amended from time to time to rationalize user fee collection & for convenience of road users. The fee rules are flexible in terms of the kind of technology to be used for user fee collection (cash, pre-paid instruments, FASTag, etc.) and the method of fee collection (open/closed tolling).

(d) &(e) Any issue in the existing toll agreements is dealt by executing agency on case to case basis as per the provisions of the respective Concession/Contract Agreement.
