PMJDY Accounts in Assam Tea Gardens

1645. SHRI NABA KUMAR SARANIA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of accounts opened under the Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) in Assam, zone-wise;
- (b) the total number of tea gardens in which accounts have been opened under the PMJDY in Assam; and
- (c) whether ATM machines have been installed in all the tea gardens of Assam and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Finance

- (a) As informed by banks 1,30,50,728 accounts have been opened under the Pradhan Mantri Jan-Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) in Assam. The District-wise data is Annexed.
- (b) As informed by the Convenor of State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC) of Assam, the total numbers of tea gardens in which accounts have been opened under the PMJDY in the state are 669.
- (c) The Convenor of State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC) of Assam has informed that 54 ATM machines are installed in the tea gardens of the state. However ATM machines have not been installed in all the tea gardens due to lack of network availability and non viability of such ATMs.
