Proposals from State Government

1665. PROF. RAVINDRA VISHWANATH GAIKWAD:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of proposals received by the Union Government from the State Government of Maharashtra during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) the number of the proposals out of the total received proposals approved and the number of the proposals lying pending; and
- (c) the time by which the pending proposals are likely to be approved by the Union Government?

(a) to (c) The Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change received 56 proposals from the State Government of Maharashtra during the last 3 years and in the current year (up to 1st July, 2018). Out of the above, 45 proposals were accorded with Environmental Clearance by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change. 11 proposals are at various stages of appraisal under Environment Impact Assessment Notification, 2006 and its amendments from time to time.
