CONTRACTUAL DOCTORS IN CGHS

1680. SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has engaged medical officers on contractual basis in CGHS dispensaries;
- (b) if so, the number of such doctors appointed during the last three years, State/ UT-wise including Delhi;
- (c) whether a large number of qualified MBBS doctors in the country are unemployed and if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government thereto; and
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to facilitate permanent appointment of doctors in CGHS dispensaries?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND
FAMILY WELFARE
(SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)**

- (a): Yes; retired GDMOs/Specialists of the Central Government/State Government/PSUs are engaged on contractual basis in CGHS dispensaries on certain terms and conditions.
- (b): The number of doctors appointed on contractual basis under CGHS during the last three years is at **Annexure**.
- (c): Details of qualified MBBS doctors in the country, who are unemployed, is not maintained centrally.
- (d): Following steps have been taken by the Govt. to facilitate permanent appointment of doctors in CGHS dispensaries:-
 - Every year on the basis of vacancies projected by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) conducts Combined Medical Services Examination for recruitment of Medical Officers of GDMO sub cadre of Central Health Services.
 - In order to encourage more doctors to join CGHS, posting of Doctors is normally being made after due consideration of their residence/domicile.
 - Promotion upto the SAG level has been made time bound under the Dynamic Assured Career Scheme.
 - The retirement age of CHS Doctors has recently been enhanced upto 65 years.
