Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to State:

- (a) the present status of implementation of Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) scheme in the country, State/UT-wise including Arunachal Pradesh and Telangana;
- (b) the details of funds spent / utilized by various States / UTs under the said scheme during the last three years and the current year, project and State / UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has framed new rules relating to disbursement of funds to States under the said schemes; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)&(b) The fund released upto 31.03.2018 to different States/Union Territories including Arunachal Pradesh and Telangana from Compensatory Afforestation Fund managed by Ad-hoc CAMPA against the Annual Plan of Operation approved by the Steering Committee of State CAMPA is placed at **Annexure-A**. The funds are utilised as per the CAMPA Guidelines.
- (c)&(d) The rules under Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act were published in Gazette on 17.02.2018 for comments / observations from the public / stakeholders and final draft Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules has been sent to Ministry of Law & Justice.
