- (a)) whether the Government is aware that a number of foreign universities have shown keen interest in setting up institutions in the country and if so, the details thereof including the proposals received from such universities;
- (b) whether it can help cater to the growing demand for quality higher education within the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that specific steps are being taken by the Government for the facilitation as well as easing of regulation for entry of foreign universities under the policy initiatives taken under the National Education Policy, 2016; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
