Petrol Pump at Giridih

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is no petrol pump on Koderma-Kovad route from Kubrimor to Giridih and ahead of Bharkatha Hatia Bazar and before the Idgah river and around Kaskatiya in Giridih district of Jharkhand State and if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the Government proposes to set up petrol pumps on both the above said places and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(c) whether the Government has received any request/representation from any public representative or social organisation in this regard and if so, the details thereof along with the action taken/being taken thereon?

MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) to (c) Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have informed that there is no petrol pump available within approximately 8 Km. from Kubrimor on Koderma-Kovad road towards Giridih and approximately 3 Km. from Koderma-Kovad road between Bharkata Hatia Bazar and Idgah river. However, based on the references received from Dr. Ravindra Kumar Ray, MP (Lok Sabha) and Human Rights Redemption Social Welfare Association of India, New Delhi, the feasibility for setting up Retail Outlets at these places has been conducted by the OMCs. These sites have been found to be viable and are included in the next round of advertisement by OMCs.
