#### KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS RUNNING IN TEMPORARY BUILDINGS

#### 1899. SHRI SIRAJUDDIN AJMAL:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details about numbers of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) running under temporary infrastructures in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is granting permanent School buildings for various KVs in the country and if so, the details thereof for the current year and for the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is aware about the abysmally dismal condition of the temporary infrastructures of Barpeta Kendriya Vidyalaya; and
- (d) if so, the details of steps taken/being taken in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

- (a) As on date, 283 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are running in the temporary infrastructure provided by sponsoring authorities in the country. The State / UT-wise details are at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) by the sponsoring authorities, availability of funds, requisite approvals etc. The details of the permanent KV school buildings sanctioned during current year and the last three years State / UT-wise are at **Annexure-II.**
- (c) & (d) KV, Barpeta was opened in the academic year 2003-04 under the sponsorship of State Government and since then the Vidyalaya is functioning from the temporary building provided by the sponsoring authority, which is not in good condition at present. It is the responsibility of the sponsoring authority to provide adequate structurally safe accommodation for running of Vidyalaya till KVS constructs its own permanent school building. However Principal, KV, Barpeta through his initiative, has undertaken some urgent repairs to the temporary building with contributions from parents and others.
