Will the **Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any assessment regarding Teacher Training Centres of all the States including Madhya Pradesh or any report in this regard has come to light;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof;
- (c) whether work of upgradation of teachers training centres is being done by the Government under consideration of the Government; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The third party evaluation of erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Teacher Education was conducted in 2017 by Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) in which 90 Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) across 11 States (Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Telengana and Uttar Pradesh) and 2 UTs (Delhi and Puducherry) were covered.

(c) & (d): The Department of School Education & Literacy has in 2017 initiated the process of strengthening the State Councils of Educational Research and Training (SCERTs) and District Institutes of Educational Research and Training (DIETs) with a focus on restructuring the existing organisational structure and strengthening of linkages with other state and district level sub-structures. Samagra Shiksha, a centrally sponsored scheme of the Govt. of India has been launched in 2018 for the school of education sector extending from pre-school to class 12 by subsuming the erstwhile three schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE). Under Samagra Shiksha, one of the focus areas is strengthening and upgradation of SCERTs/SIEs and DIETs as nodal agencies for teacher training. The guidelines of Samagra Shiksha have recommended organizational restructuring of the SCERTs and DIETs, creation of a separate cadre for teacher educators and recruitment of high quality people for academic posts in these TEIs.
