- (a) the total number of educational institutions/colleges/universities opened by the Government post-bifurcation of State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the total funds released and spent for each institutes or Universities in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that requests are pending from Andhra Pradesh in this regard; and
- (d) if so, the time by which action would be taken by the Government?

(a) to (d): In pursuance of the Andhra Pradesh Re-organisation Act, 2014 seven Central Institutions i.e. One IIT, one NIT, one IIM, one IISER, one IIIT, one Central University and one Tribal University are being established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development in Andhra Pradesh. The details are as follows:

Sl. No.	Institutions	Status/Amount Released
1.	IIT, Tirupati	IIT Tirupati has been established and its academic session has commenced from the year 2015-16. As on

		date Rs. 110.04 crore has been released to the Institute.
2.	NIT Andhra Pradesh	NIT Andhra Pradesh has been established as per schedule 13 (Education) of AP Reorganization Act, 2014. Till date an amount of Rs. 73.50 Crore has been released to NIT Andhra Pradesh.
3.	IIM Vishakhapatnam	IIM Vishakhapatnam has started functioning from temporary campus from the year 2015-16. Till date an amount of Rs. 56.83 Crore has been released to the Institute.
4.	IISER Tirupati	IISER Tirupati has started functioning from temporary campus from 2015-16. Till date an Amount of Rs. 109.02 Crore has been released to the Institute.
5.	IITDM, Kurnool	IITDM Kurnool has been opened post bifurcation of State of Andhra Pradesh. The Institute has commenced its academic session from 2015-16. A total of Rs. 20.10 crore has been released to the Institute so far.
6.	Central University, Ananthapur District	For establishment of Central University, the land has been identified at Ananthapur district. 1 <sup>st</sup> installment of Rs. 5.0 crores has been released to University Grants Commission for starting the academic session in transit campus (2018-19)
7.	Tribal University, Vizianagaram District	The land for establishment of Tribal University, Andhra Pradesh has been identified at Vizianagaram District.
