FUNDS FOR DRINKING WATER

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether any funds has been allocated for providing drinking water and laying sewer pipes in Nashik, Maharashtra;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the details of the work done through the said funds?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a), (b) & (c). Water Supply and Sewerage & Septage Management are the major components of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). However, funds are not allocated city/sector wise. Under AMRUT, selection, appraisal, approval and implementation of individual projects is done by the concerned

State/UT. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs approves only the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) submitted by the States/Union Territories (UTs) and releases Central Assistance as per Mission guidelines.

For the State of Maharashtra, the Ministry has approved SAAPs worth ₹ 7,759.32 crore for the entire Mission period, which includes Water Supply projects costing ₹ 3,769.70 crore and Sewerage projects costing ₹ 3,715.62 crore.

In Nashik, State Government has taken up one project in Sewerage sector at a cost of \gtrless 82.25 crore for which contract has been awarded.
