**(a), (b) & (c). Water Supply and Sewerage & Septage Management are the major components of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). However, funds are not allocated city/sector wise. Under AMRUT, selection, appraisal, approval and implementation of individual projects is done by the concerned**

**State/UT. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs approves only the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) submitted by the States/Union Territories (UTs) and releases Central Assistance as per Mission guidelines.**

**For the State of Maharashtra, the Ministry has approved SAAPs worth ₹ 7,759.32 crore for the entire Mission period, which includes Water Supply projects costing ₹ 3,769.70 crore and Sewerage projects costing ₹ 3,715.62 crore.**

**In Nashik, State Government has taken up one project in Sewerage sector at a cost of ₹ 82.25 crore for which contract has been awarded.**
