STREAMLINING VISA AND IMMIGRATION PROCESS

(a) and (b): Government has implemented Immigration Visa, Foreigners Registration and Tracking (IVFRT) Project to streamline the twin processes of Immigration and Visa for Indians as well as Foreigners. Various online modules like e-Visa application, Advance passenger Information (API), e-FRRO, C-Form for hoteliers/hospitals/guest houses etc., S-Form for educational institutions, Unique Case Files for Indians and Foreigners, Visa on Arrival for Japanese nationals etc have been implemented/operationalized to streamline this process.
