**IMMIGRATION COUNTERS AT DELHI AIRPORT** 

2199. PROF. PREM SINGH CHANDUMAJRA:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently ordered the closure of exclusive immigration counters at Delhi Airport;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to extend this scheme to other International Airports;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State and Airport-wise particularly in Punjab;
- (e) whether the new scheme is causing hardships to premium class passengers; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and corrective steps proposed in this regard?

  ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (f): There is no proposal to close the exclusive immigration counters provided at Delhi Airport. Separate immigration counters for Business/First class passengers are available at Delhi and Mumbai airports. In order to facilitate passengers and fast track the immigration process, Govt. Of India is increasing the number of departure/arrival counters and man-power at major airports on need basis.
