(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. As per the Third Advance Estimates for the crop year 2017-18, the estimated production of foodgrains is 279.51 million tonnes which is a new record. Further, the estimated production of all four major foodgrains viz. rice, wheat, nutri / coarse cereals and pulses for the year 2017-18 is a new record.

The details of the record production of foodgrains including all four major crops as per the Third Advance Estimates for the crop year 2017-18 are given as under:

- Foodgrains 279.51 million tonnes
- Rice 111.52 million tonnes
- Wheat 98.61 million tonnes
- Nutri/Coarse Cereals 44.87 million tonnes
- Maize 26.88 million tonnes
- Pulses 24.51 million tonnes
- Gram 11.16 million tonnes
- Urad 3.28 million tonnes
