Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the number of posts filled through the Civil services examinations conducted by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) have been reduced during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of posts filled through civil services examinations since the year 2009 till date, year-wise;
- (d) whether the vacant posts are to be filled in the different cadres of All India Services; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the details of vacancies, State-wise?

(a) to (c) : The details of the year wise number of candidates allocated to various services from Civil Services Examination (CSE) 2009 to Civil Services Examination (CSE 2016) is 933, 987, 957, 1046, 1196, 1190, 1041, 1058 respectively. Thus, no such trend is observed. The detail of actual filling up of posts is not centrally maintained.

(d) & (e) : The occurrence of vacancies and its filling up is a continuous and ongoing process. The details of State Wise Vacancies for three All India Services i.e. Indian Administrative Services, Indian Police Services and Indian Forest Services are placed at Annexure-I, II and III respectively.
