(a) & (b): Defence Budget (including Pension and Miscellaneous Budget) from Financial Year 2015-16 to 2018-19 are increasing as per table below:-

(c) Details of allocations made and expenditure against the same for the last two fiscal in respect of Defence is tabulated below:-

2017-18	3,59,854.12	3,80,131.60

As per above table the total expenditure has exceeded allocations in the last two financial years.

(d) & (e): In view of (c) above, does not arise. However, the allocated budgetary resources are optimally utilized towards meeting the operational requirements of the Armed Forces. Depending upon the allocated resources, schemes are also reprioritized to ensure that urgent and critical capabilities are acquired without compromise of operational preparedness.
