- (a) whether the Government is laying Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from Chennai, Tamil Nadu to Port Blair, Andaman and Nicober Islands and if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (b) the time by which the said project is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) Yes Madam, the details are as follows
 - i. Government has approved a project to lay Submarine Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from Mainland India [Chennai] to eight (8) Islands of Andaman & Nicobar namely; Port Blair, Car Nicobar, Little Andaman, Havelock, Kamorta, Great Nicobar, Rangat Island and Long Island.
 - BSNL is nominated as Project Execution Agency.
 - BSNL has placed Purchase Order (PO) to its vendor (NEC) on 26.06.2018.
 - ii. The timeline for the completion of Project is two years from the award of work by BSNL.
