Goods and Services Tax Network

2798. DR. KIRIT P. SOLANKI: SHRI OM BIRLA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of businesses, individuals and unofficial entities that are registered with the Goods and Services Tax Network (GSTN);
- **(b)** the percentage of total registered businesses, individuals and unofficial entities that are using the GSTN to file their returns and pay taxes;
- (c) whether the GSTN has suffered any technical glitches since it became operational and if so, the present capacity of GSTN and steps taken to reduce such glitches in the future; and
- (d) whether the GSTN includes a provision for an offline utility for entry of details to reduce inadvertent errors that might occur during online filing and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI SHIV PRATAP SHUKLA)

- a) The number of taxpayers registered under GST, as per their constitution, as on 29.07.2018, are given in the Annexure-1.
- b) All the taxpayers are filing their GST Returns through the GST Infrastructure, either through the GST Portal, or through their GSP (GST Suvidha Provider). The month-wise percentage filing for the Financial Year 2018-19, as on 26.07.2018, is

given in the Annexure-2.

- c) GST Portal faced unplanned downtime due to technical glitches on six separate occasions since it became operational. Immediately upon receiving the alert of malfunctioning on the above dates of the Hardware/Software Component through GST System monitoring apparatus, the technical team of GSTN, MSP Infosys and OEM manufacturer were activated to diagnose and resolve the problem. Root cause was identified and expeditiously rectified. To prevent future incidents, additional monitoring has been established. The processes for routine maintenance of the effected Software/Hardware component has been recalibrated to ensure safeguards against similar issues in future.
