- whether the monthly revenue average from GST was at Rs. 89,885 crore for the said period and if so, the details thereof; and
- whether the deficit perturbing, with rising compliance and e-way bills, collections too may rise this year and if so, the details thereof?

(c): The introduction of e-way bill is expected to improve overall Goods and Services Tax (GST) compliance. The gross revenue collection in the month of April, 2018 (Rs.1,03,459 crore), May, 2018 (Rs. 94,016 crore), June, 2018 (Rs. 95,610 crore) and July, 2018 (Rs.

96,483) which is higher than the monthly average of GST collection in the last financial year FY 2017-18 i.e. Rs 89,885 crore.
