SHELTER HOMES FOR WOMEN

2859: DR. RAVINDRA BABU:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Shelter Homes for women in the country, both in the Government and private sector;
- (b) the total number of women benefited by these homes during each of the last three years and the current year State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether these homes are also providing vocational training to women; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the efforts being made for their useful employment after training?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR)

(a) : The Ministry of Women and Child Development implements the Swadhar Greh Scheme which targets the women victims of unfortunate circumstances. As on 30.07.2018, 518 Swadhar Grehs are functioning in the country.

Ujjawala scheme has been implemented by this Ministry for eradicating the menace of trafficking in the country. As on 30.07.2018, there are 148 Ujjawala (Preventive & Rehabilitative) homes in the country.

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment implements a Central Sector Scheme of Integrated Programme for Senior Citizens (IPSrC) under which grants in aid are given for running and maintenance of Senior Citizens Homes (Old Age Homes)/ Senior Citizens' Homes. As on 25.07.2018, 8 Senior Citizens' Homes for elderly women are functioning in the Country.

- (b) : The total number of women benefitted under Swadhar Greh Scheme during each of the last three years and the current year is at **Annexure-I.** The details of the beneficiaries during the last three years and current year, year-wise in various States/UTs under Ujjawala scheme is as **Annexure II**. A statement showing number of women benefitted during last three years and current year, State/ UT wise is at **Annexure-III**.
- (c) & (d): This Ministry provides support for vocational training to the implementing agencies under Swadhar Greh and Ujjawala schemes through recognized Vocational Training Institutes to completely rehabilitate the victims by providing alternative livelihood options.
