- (a) the total details of funds provided under various Central schemes during the financial year 2017-18, State-wise;
- (b) the details of the amount received and utilised by the State Government of Jharkhand;
- (c) whether the State Government of Jharkhand has given any clarification regarding the amount not utilized by it; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Total funds allocated for schemes during the year 2017-18 is as below:

Centrally Sponsored Scheme	2,78,433.23	2,85,581.44
Central Sector Scheme	6,63,663.02	6,34,318.08

The Central Government/ Ministry of Finance allocates Budgetary funds to different Ministries/ Departments demand wise for each scheme. Department of Expenditure does not monitor individual schemes State wise. Concerned Ministry / Department periodically monitors the individual schemes. The release of funds/ instalment is based on the furnished UC of the penultimate (last to last) instalment. For avoiding the back-loading of expenditure towards the end of the year, there is a ceiling of 33% and 15% of budgetary outlay for respective scheme in the last quarter and the last month of the financial year respectively. Sufficient funds lie with the line Ministries for making releases in accordance with the individual scheme guidelines and implementation structure. To establish an efficient fund flow system, the funds of CSSs are released to the States through the Public Financial Management System (PFMS).
