CONTRIBUTION OF TOURISM SECTOR IN GDP

3026. SHRIMATI POONAMBEN MAADAM:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the contribution made by the Tourism sector to the nation's total Gross Domestic Product(GDP);
- (b) whether there has been an increase in foreign tourist arrivals in the country in 2017-2018;
- (c) if so, the details thereof with regard to percentage increase; and
- (d) the details of income earned from foreign tourist arrivals in the year 2017-2018?

ANSWER

- (a): According to the report of 2nd Tourism Satellite Account for India, the contribution of tourism to GDP for the latest year available i.e. 2012-13 was 6.88%.
- (b) and (c): Yes, Madam. The Foreign Tourist Arrivals during the financial year 2017-18 was 10.38 million (provisional) registering an annual growth of 14.3%.
- (d): The estimated Foreign Exchange Earning through tourism during the financial year 2017-18 was Rs.1,84,971 crore registering an annual growth of 15.9%.
