Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of faculty position in Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Visakhapatnam;
- (b) whether the Ministry thinks that release of Rs. 55.96 crores in four years and Rs. 42 crores in 2018-19 helps to complete the campus and other infrastructure at the end of the Twelfth Five Year Plan; and
- (c) whether the Ministry has allotted Rs.300 crores a year to compete it in the coming two years and, if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a): At present, all the 11 sanctioned posts of faculty in Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Visakhapatnam are filled. Requirement of additional faculty, if any, is met from/through mentor institute (IIM Bangalore) or from industry or other institutes on visiting basis.
- (b): Rs. 56.84 Crore has been released to IIM Visakhapatnam so far for running the institute from temporary campus.
- (c): The funds for permanent campus sanctioned is Rs. 445 crore and shall be released after due process is completed.
