MISSING OF VALUABLE ARTICLES FROM MUSEUMS

3077. Shri Raghav Lakhanpal:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any valuable articles have reportedly gone missing from various museums across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the current year, Museum-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any investigation in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken against the culprits including staff/officers found responsible/involved therein; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to prevent recurrence of such incidents?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d) Three decorative art objects bearing GAR No.799, GAR No 822 and GAR No.860 have been reportedly missing from Allahabad Museum, Allahabad since 8th April, 2012. The matter is subjudice before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad.
- (e) Periodical verification as well as Annual stock verification in the Museums is done as per schedule. Further, a well established security system, with modern security gadgets is in place. The activities, including security measures in respect of the museums under Ministry of Culture are also reviewed periodically.
