- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps for the preservation and conservation of various temples including ancient temples in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh?

- (a) Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has 3687 protected monuments of National importance in the country including temples. The details of protected temples in the State of Uttar Pradesh are given in Annexure.
- (b) The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred for conservation of protected monuments under ASI including temples are as under :
