Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the sub-committee constituted under the Central Advisory Board of Education has recommended to set up residential degree colleges/polytechnic colleges/special women universities for women in every district headquarters and free education for women upto post graduation level; and
- (b) if so, the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government on the said recommendations?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): In order to encourage girl education, a Sub-Committee under Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) has been constituted to look into the issues related to Girls' Education. The interim recommendations of sub-committee, *inter alia*, include (i) Residential Degree Colleges and Polytechnics for Women in the District Head Quarters, (ii) Exclusive Women University in each State, (iii) Provide free education to Girls upto Post-graduate level.

All the recommendations of the Sub-committee under CABE are interim. The final report of the Sub-committee has not been finalized.
