Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has introduced various scholarships for the students studying in schools in the country and if so, the details thereof during the last three years and the current year, year and scholarship-wise;
- (b) the number of students applied for scholarship and amount released by the Government during the last three years, State/UT-wise and year-wise;
- (c) whether several students are not receiving scholarships in time particularly the students from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and economically weaker section and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to ensure timely action in this regard; and
- (e) whether the Government has started transfer scholarship amount directly into the beneficiary student account and if so, the details thereof along with the number of students benefited till date?

ANSWER MINISTEROFSTATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

(a): Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education & Literacy is administering two scholarship schemes viz. National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) and National Scheme of Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education (NSIGSE).

- (b): The sanctioned amount for NMMSS and NSIGSE along with number of beneficiaries during last three years (i.e. 2015-16 to 2017-18 and the current year 2018-19 (as on 31.07.2018) are given at **Annexure I and II** respectively.
- (c) & (d): The release of scholarship and incentives under these schemes is a continuous process. All the proposals, complete in all respect, received in the Ministry for release of scholarships under NMMSS and incentive under NSIGSE up to the academic year 2016-17 have been processed and amount has been sanctioned/released. The proposals for the Academic Year 2017-18 are at various stages of approval/release.
- (e): Yes, Madam. Both the Schemes are covered under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme of the Government of India. So far, 3,16,028 girls under NSIGSE and 9,56,539 students under NMMSS have been benefitted by direct transfer of the incentive/scholarship amount to their bank accounts.
