- (a) whether Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme has been implemented in Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds released to Madhya Pradesh under the said programme during each of the last three years; and
- (d) the status of progress made so far in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Under Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), 50 projects have been sanctioned for the State of Madhya Pradesh for construction of 13,635 houses involving central assistance of Rs. 160.31 crore.

(c) Of the central assistance involved in these projects, Rs. 194.52 crore were released uptil Financial Year 2014-15. Excess release of central assistance was due to curtailment of houses/cancelation of project (s) by State at a later stage. No central grant under IHSDP was released to the State of Madhya Pradesh during the last three years.

(d) As reported by the State Government, construction of 12,188 houses has been completed and 10,524 houses have been occupied by the beneficiaries.
