FULL BODY TRUCK SCANNERS

3287. DR. UDIT RAJ:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that there is an inordinate delay in installation of Full Body Truck Scanners (FBTS) at the vulnerable points along the Indo-Pak Border, Indo-Bangladesh Border and Indo-Nepal Border considering the importance of these borders as entry and exit points of terror groups in and out of the country;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps the Government proposes to take to expedite installation of FBTS?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

(a) to (c): No. The Government has placed order for procurement of five numbers of Full Body Truck Scanners (FBTS) for installation at Attari,

Poonch – Chakan-da-bagh and Uri-Salamabad along the Indo-Pak Border;

Petrapole on Indo-Bangladesh Border and Raxaul on Indo-Nepal Border. The procurement is done in accordance with the laid down procedure and after obtaining requisite clearances from various agencies.
