**FULL BODY TRUCK SCANNERS**

**3287. DR. UDIT RAJ:**

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

**(a) whether it is true that there is an inordinate delay in installation of Full Body Truck Scanners (FBTS) at the vulnerable points along the Indo-Pak Border, Indo-Bangladesh Border and Indo-Nepal Border considering the importance of these borders as entry and exit points of terror groups in and out of the country;**

**(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and**

**(c) the steps the Government proposes to take to expedite installation of FBTS?**

**(a) to (c): No. The Government has placed order for procurement of five numbers of Full Body Truck Scanners (FBTS) for installation at Attari, Poonch – Chakan-da-bagh and Uri-Salamabad along the Indo-Pak Border; Petrapole on Indo-Bangladesh Border and Raxaul on Indo-Nepal Border. The procurement is done in accordance with the laid down procedure and after obtaining requisite clearances from various agencies.**
