#### TRAINS TO TIRUPATI

#### **3622. SHRIMATI BUTTA RENUKA:**

#### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of trains running between Hyderabad/Secunderabad to Tirupati and vice versa;
- (b) the average number of passengers per day who travel between Hyderabad/ Secunderabad and Tirupati and vice versa by Railways:
- (c) whether there is any proposal to introduce non-stop Duronto Express (Night Train) between Hyderabad and Tirupati and vice versa;
- (d) if so, the time by when the train will be introduced; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a) Presently, 17 pairs of Mail/Express trains are running between Hyderabad/Secunderabad and Tirupati area.
- (b) During the period from April 2018 to June 2018, the daily average number of passengers who travelled from Hyderabad / Secunderabad / Kacheguda to Tirupati/Renigunta were 3663 while in reverse direction this figure was 3514.
- (c) to (e) No, Madam. At present, there is no proposal to introduce a Duronto Express between Hyderabad and Tirupati due to operational and resource constraints.
