SAFETY FROM FAKE NEWS

3634. SHRI HARISH MEENA:

Will the Minister of Electronics & Information Technology be pleased to state:-

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to educate people to stay safe from fake information being circulated on social media;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to create a platform where a citizen can identify fake news or hoaxes; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI S.S. AHLUWALIA)

- (a): Government has taken several initiatives for user awareness relating to cyber safety. The Indian Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT-In) issues advisories about cyber safety and security. Ministry of Electronics and Information technology (MeitY), through a program namely Information Security Education & Awareness (ISEA), has been highlighting the importance of following the ethics while using Internet and advice not to share rumours/fake news. Government has also asked WhatsApp to convey various steps taken by them to deal with fake news and also to share learning material to educate the same.
- (a) and (c): Presently, there is no such proposal with MeitY.
