- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up de-addiction centres at Gram Panchayats level in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh;
- (c) whether new de-addiction centres have been set up in the country including Madhya Pradesh during the last three years and the current year;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (e) the details of the achievements of the said centres during the said period?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PANCHAYATI RAJ (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) to (d) Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment has informed that it implements a "Central Sector Scheme of Assistance for Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse" under which financial assistance is provided to Non-Governmental Organisations, Panchayati Raj Institutions, Urban Local Bodies etc. for, *inter-alia*, running and maintenance of Integrated Rehabilitation Centres for Addicts (IRCAs). Under the said scheme, the Ministry also supports IRCAs working in rural areas. The details of new de-addiction centres assisted during last three years are given at Annexure.
