Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress made on six laning of access controlled Bangalore-Mysore section of Bangalore-Mallapuram Economic Corridor and widening to two lanes with paved shoulders from Kottigehara-Modigere handpost of NH 73 as on date;
- (b) whether there has been inordinate delay in construction of these important road projects; and
- (c) the timeline for the completion of construction work of these highway projects?

- (a) The work for 6-laning of Bangalore-Nidagatta-Mysore road stretch has been awarded in two packages in February, 2018. The work for widening to two lanes with paved shoulders of Kottigehara-Modigere road stretch has also been awarded in May, 2018.

- (c) The scheduled completion time for 6-laning of Bangalore-Nidagatta-Mysore road stretch is 30 months from the appointed date and 18 months for widening to two lanes with paved shoulders of Kottigehara-Modigere road stretch from the appointed date.
