Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state :

(a) the number of medals won in various sports by Madhya Pradesh during the last four years;

(b) the details of sports training facilities created and funds allocated under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes for promotion of sports in Madhya Pradesh during the said period;

(c) whether the Government proposes to increase participation of sportspersons from Madhya Pradesh in national and international level sports events; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS [COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (Retd.)]

(a) : Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports does not maintain state-wise data regarding the number of medals won in national and international sports events including those from Madhya Pradesh.

(b) : The Ministry was implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan during the period 2014-15 and

2015-16. No sports training facilities were created under this scheme in the State of Madhya Pradesh.

However, grant-in-aid has been sanctioned for creation of sports infrastructure facilities in the State of Madhya Pradesh under the Ministry's Central Sector Schemes namely Urban Sports Infrastructure Scheme (USIS) and Khelo India.

Details of sports infrastructure projects sanctioned in the State of Madhya Pradesh under Urban Sports Infrastructure Scheme (USIS) and Khelo India Scheme during last four years are as under :

(c) & (d) : The Central Government does not have a role in increasing the participation of sportspersons from States including those from Madhya Pradesh in international and national sports events. Representation of sportspersons from States for participation in national and international sports events is dependent on a number of factors such as entries filed by the State Sports Federations for participation in national level tournaments, meeting the standards of selection criteria fixed by the National Sports Federations for participation in various international sports events.
