Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated and utilized under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF) during the last three years, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra and project-wise;
- (b) the details of the projects pending under RIDF during the said period; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to complete these projects in time?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Rural Development was sanctioned a National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development loan of Rs.18,500 crore in the year 2007-08 for construction/up-gradation of rural roads under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY). This loan was drawn in three installments from 2007-08 to 2009-10 (Rs. 4,500 crore in 2007-08, Rs.7,500 crore in 2008-09 and Rs. 6,500 crore in 2009-10). This loan amount has been utilized as a source of consolidated pool amount for execution of PMGSY works. The said loan amount has been fully repaid by the financial year 2016-17 including Maharashtra. No new projects are being undertaken under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF).

Under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) in 2017-18 a loan of Rs.7329.43 crore was availed from NABARD and in 2018-19 no loan has been availed till date.
