CONSTRUCTION OF AIRPORT AT JEWAR

be pleased to state:-

- (a): whether at present the Indira Gandhi International Airport at Delhi is handling close to 62 million passengers per year which is predicted to go up to 110 million in the next 7 years, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b): whether any proposal is pending with the Ministry to develop a new airport at Jewar near the National Capital Region with a view to ease congestion at Delhi Airport and to handle 30-50 million additional travellers per annum and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c): whether the Ministry has accorded in-principle clearance for a Greenfield airport at Jewar and if so, the details thereof;**
- (d): whether the task of notifying and acquiring 3000 hectares of land for the purpose of this world-class airport has been entrusted to the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority, if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e): the particulars as to the cost outlay for this new airport as well as the time-frame by which it would be operational?**

ANSWER

(a): Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) has handled 65.7 million passengers in 2017-18. Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) is also undertaking airport expansion project which includes re-development of Terminal 1, laying of new Runway, expansion of Terminal 3. The developments will be undertaken in a phased manner as per the Master Plan so that additional capacities are available in time for catering to the future traffic growth.

(b) & (c): Government of India, Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) has granted 'in principle' approval to Government of Uttar Pradesh (GoUP) for setting up of Noida International Greenfield Airport near Jewar on

08.05.2018.

(d): Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) has been appointed as the implementing agency by GoUP. A total of 3000 ha of land area for the proposed airport is a part of notified area of YEIDA and the Authority has reserved the land for proposed Airport in its Master Plan as per GoUP.

(e): The capital expenditure of the project is estimated to be around Rs. 15,754 crores and the construction is to be done in four phases. However, timelines of construction of the airport depends upon several factors such as selection of Concessionaire, acquisition of land, availability of all the mandatory clearance, financial closure, connectivity, utility services, etc.
