Will the Minister of DRINKINGWATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Governments have submitted their proposals to the Union Government seeking foreign assistance for providing safe drinking water to all households;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of the households likely to be covered under this scheme;
- (d) the details of drinking water projects provided foreign assistance during each of the last four years and the amount provided to each of these projects and their current status; and
- (e) the details of the funds provided to Rajasthan in this regard?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

- (a) to (c)Yes Madam. The Drinking Water project proposals of the States seeking foreign assistance from Institutions like World Bank, Japan International cooperation agency (JICA), Asian Development Bank (ADB), New Development Bank (NDB), Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) are received in this Ministry for technical examination. After the technical examination, the proposals are recommended to Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), Ministry of Finance for further necessary action. The details of such projects received during last two years and the population planned to be benefitted by these proposals is at Annexure.
- (d) & (e) Oncesuch project proposalsare posed by DEAto External Financial Institutions and subsequently approved by them, theyenter into a bilateral agreement. As per the agreement, the funds are provided directly to the State Government. However, for World Bank assisted Rural Water Supply & Sanitation Projects for Low Income States (being implemented in Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand & Uttar Pradesh) for which agreement was made by this Ministry in 2013-14, the fund (external aid component under the project) were provided to the states in various years is as under:
