ACCIDENT PRONE STRETCHES ON NHs

3825. COL. SONARAM CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether accident prone stretches have been identified on the National Highways, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether National Highways Ambulance Service has been introduced along with setting up of the Trauma Centres on those stretches for providing emergency medical facilities; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The Ministry has identified 789 road accident black spots in various States (out of which 650 are on National Highways). Ministry has provided cranes and ambulance to various State Government under the National Highway Accident Relief Service Scheme. National Highway Authority of India has also provided ambulances, cranes etc on the stretches developed by the concessionaire and other completed stretches of National Highways under its operation and maintenance contracts.
